
#### **Liquid Crystal Precautions**

If the LCD screen on the radio is damaged, do not to touch the liquid crystal fluid. If anyof the following situations happen, take the action indicated:


- 1 If the liquid crystal fluid comes in contact with your skin, wipe the skin area with a cloth and then wash the skin thoroughly with soap and running water.
- 2 If the liquid crystal fluid gets into your eye, flush the eye with clean water for at least 15 minutes. Seek medical care.
- 3 If the liquid crystal fluid is ingested, flush your mouth thoroughly with water. Drink large quantities of water and induce vomiting. Seek medical care.



#### 5-Way Navigation Knob

IMPORTANT: If your vehicle's audio system has an audio input or a cassette player the following instructions tell you how to install your MiRGE yourself. If your vehicle does not have an audio input or a cassette player, we strongly recommend that you have your MiRGE professionally installed.

If your vehicle requires professional installation you will need to use either the XM Sure Connect (sold separately) or the XM FM Direct adapter (sold separately).

# Step 1: Decide on a Location for your Radio: Vent, Dashboard or Console?

You can use either the included vent mount or adhesive mount for your radio, depending on your particular situation.




Adhesive Pad

#### Installing the vent mount

- Locate a vent with horizontal slats sturdy enough to hold the vehicle dock and radio.
- 2 Adjust the clamps to fit your vent.
- 3 Snap the mount onto the vent.

To remove, push the mount into the vent, then lift up.



#### Installing the Adhesive Mount



**CAUTION!** The adhesive used with the swivel mount may make it difficult to remove. Do not install this mount on leather surfaces and make sure the air temperature is at least 60°F (15°C).

- 1 Locate a flat surface for the mount. Make sure there is ample room for the vehicle dock and radio when installed.
- 2 Clean the surface with the alcohol pad and let it dry thoroughly.
- 3 Peel off the adhesive liner. Position, press, and hold the adhesive mount in place for 30 seconds.
- IMPORTANT! Let the adhesive cure for 2 3 hours before attaching the vehicle dock and radio to the mount.
  - 4 Turn the swivel to accommodate the vehicle dock and radio. Adjust the tension via the center screw.








You can turn this screw with a screwdriver to adjust the tension of the mount.

To remove the swivel mount, carefully lift the adhesive pad with your fingers or a spoon. Warming the pad with a hair dryer for several minutes will help soften the adhesive.


#### Step 2: Mounting the Interoperable Vehicle Antenna

1 Mount the antenna on the outside of your vehicle, in a location that will always face the sky. The antenna contains a strong magnet that will stick to any metal part of your vehicle. Leave at least 3" of metal around each side of the antenna. Use the rubber tail cover to hide and protect the exposed wire.





- 2 Route the antenna wire under the rubber molding around the back windshield, into the seal around the trunk. Then route the wire along the trunk wall and into the cabin interior from there.
- 3 Hide the antenna wire inside the cabin. The best way to hide the antenna wire depends on your vehicle. It's usually easiest to run the wire from the rear of the vehicle to the front (towards the radio) by routing it along the interior trim where it meets the carpet. Gently push the cable under the edges of the plastic trim all the way to the front of the cabin, then bring the cable out from the trim and route it under the carpet to the dashboard or console. Plug the antenna connector into the Vehicle Dock and coil any extra wire under the carpet or floor mat.






TIP! Always be careful to include enough slack in your wire to accommodate open doors or trunk lids. Use things typically found around the home, like electrical tape, to secure wires in areas so that hinges do not pinch the wire with the door. Hide any excess wire in the trim or under the carpet or a floor mat.

#### Antenna placement options for other types of vehicles:


- Pickup Truck: On the roof towards the front of the cab, above the front windshield, centered between the left and right sides.
- Convertible: On the trunk lid, at least 3" from any edge, centered between the left and right sides.


#### Step 3: Connect your MiRGE.


- 1 Plug the Antenna into the Vehicle Dock's ANT IN connection.
- 2 Plug the Vehicle Power Adapter into the Vehicle Dock's DC IN connection.
- 3 Plug one of the audio adapters into the Vehicle Dock's AUDIO OUT connection:
  - Use the Aux In Cable if your vehicle's audio system has an audio input.
  - Use the Cassette Adapter if your vehicle has a built-in cassette player.
- 4 Insert the Vehicle Dock into the Vent Mount or Adhesive Mount.
- 5 Insert your MiRGE into the Vehicle Dock.
- NOTE! If your vehicle's audio system does not have a cassette player or an audio input, you will use either the XM SureConnect (sold separately) or the FM Direct adapter (sold separately). A professional installation is strongly recommended if you choose either of these methods. Professional installation can help improve your radio's reception and significantly reduce the visibility of wires. To learn more, go to xmradio.com/mirgeaccessories.
  - XM SureConnect (sold separately): Lets you listen to your MiRGE through your vehicle's FM radio. Simply find an unused FM frequency on the FM radio and set your MiRGE to transmit on that same frequency. Refer to Find an FM frequency page 55 for more information.
  - XM FM Direct Adapter (sold separately): Directly connects the MiRGE to your vehicle's FM radio via its antenna input.



#### Step 4: Turn on your MiRGE and Test for Sound

- Turn on your car radio.
- 2 Insert the Cassette Adapter or plug in the Aux In Cable.
- NOTE! If you are using the XM SureConnect or the XM FM Direct adapter, refer to Turn the FM Modulator ON/OFF on page 54 for more information.
  - 3 Press the Power button to turn your MiRGE ON.





# Activation

# Activation

Before you can listen to any SIRIUS or XM channels, you must first activate your MIRGE.




NOTE! Make sure that SIRIUS is the active radio service by pressing the SAT button. See page 28.

- 1 Make sure your MiRGE is properly installed and receiving the SIRIUS signal so that you can hear the audio on SIRIUS Channel 184.
- 2 Make a note of your radio's ID number. You can find it:
  - . On Channel O on either SIRIUS or XM.
  - · On the rear package label
  - · On the label on the back of your MiRGE
- 3 Activate your service:
  - Online: Go to www.sirius.com/MiRGE
     OR
  - By phone: call 1-888-539-SIRIUS (1-888-539-7474)
- 4 When your service is activated, your MiRGE will receive all SIRIUS and XM channels you've subscribed to. This usually takes 10 to 15 minutes, but may take up to an hour. Your radio must remain ON until activated.

# **Using your MiRGE**

#### **Display Screen Information**

Your SIRIUS XM MiRGE's display screen provides information about the operation of the radio, such as the currently tuned service and channel, the song or show being played, the artist's name, time and other information. This screen is referred to as the *Default Display* in this manual. The illustration below identifies the information shown on the default display when listening to a typical broadcast.



Whenever you power the MiRGE **ON**, the radio service and channel that were previously selected will automatically begin playing, and the currently-playing artist name and song title will be displayed.

#### Split-screen display mode

You can change the display to a split-screen mode that shows multiple channels simultaneously. This lets you see what else is playing. You can choose from:

To cycle-through the different modes in Live, press the DISPLAY button.




TIP! When in split screen with the Channel List, you can scroll through the list of channels, just like when it appears on the Default Display. Press < or > to change categories. Press the Select button to select a channel.

#### Listening to SIRIUS and XM

#### Selecting the radio service

1 The currently-active radio service logo is shown in the display's channel information bar.





2 Press the SAT button on the radio or remote to switch to the other radio service. The MiRGE will play the channel that was last tuned in that service.

#### Selecting a channel

- 1 Turn the knob (radio) or use the UP/DOWN buttons (remote) to scroll through the list of channels.
- 2 You'll see the channel's logo and current artist. In a few seconds, the current song title appears.
- 3 Press the Select button to select a channel.





**TIP!** You can configure the MiRGE to automatically tune to the channel you scroll to. Refer to page 34 for instructions.

# **Using your MiRGE**

#### View a category

SIRIUS XM has organized its channels into categories to make it easier for you to find the ones you want.


- 1 To view the different categories, press < or >.
- 2 Use the knob (radio) or UP/DOWN buttons (remote) to scroll through the current category's channels to find the channel you want.
- 3 Press the Select button to tune to the channel.



TIP! To briefly listen to each channel in the category, select  $\mathbf{S}_{\mathsf{CAN}}$ , then press the  $\mathbf{S}_{\mathsf{ELECT}}$  button.

#### Direct channel entry

- 1 Be sure you are in the Direct tuning mode. Press the FAV button until DIRECT shows as the tuning mode.
- 2 Use the Number buttons to enter the channel number.




#### Jump to the previous channel

Press the Jump button to listen to the previous channel you selected.


# **Using your MiRGE**

#### Set your favorite channels

You can assign up to 10 of your favorite channels in each satellite service to the number buttons so you can quickly access them.

#### To assign a favorite channel to a number button:

- 1 Tune to the desired channel.
- 2 Be sure you are in Favorite
  Channels mode. Press the
  Fav button until FAVORITE
  CHANNELS shows as the
  tuning mode.
- 3 Press and hold the Number button you want to use for that channel.



#### To listen to a Favorite channel:

- Be sure you are in the Favorite Channels tuning mode. Press the Fav button until FAVORITE CHANNELS shows as the tuning mode.
- 2 Press the Number button where you assigned the desired channel.

**NOTE!** You can only select favorite channels within the active radio service in Live mode.



TIP! To see a list of your Favorite Channels, press < or >. To listen to a channel from the list, use the **knob** to highlight it and press the **S**ELECT **button.** 

# **Using your MiRGE**

#### Automatically tune to a channel (Direct Tuning):

Usually, you press the **S**ELECT button to tune to a channel. You can change this so that your MiRGE automatically tunes to a channel when it remains highlighted in the Channel List for longer than 3 seconds.

#### To activate Direct Tuning:

- Press the Menu button.
- 2 Highlight Channel Access, and press the Select button.
- 3 Highlight Direct Tune, and press the Select button.
- 4 Turn the knob until Direct Tune is ON.
- 5 Press the Select button.

#### To disable Direct Tuning:

- 1 Press the Menu button.
- 2 Highlight CHANNEL Access, and press the Select button.
- 3 Highlight Direct Tune, and press the Select button.
- 4 Turn the knob until DIRECT TUNE is OFF.
- 5 Press the Select button.

# **Special Features**

#### 60-Minute Replay Buffer

The MiRGE's 60-Minute Replay Buffer gives you the opportunity to "hear that again." This feature applies to the current channel only. Changing channels or services, or turning your MiRGE **OFF** removes all tracks from the Replay Buffer.

Both split screen modes will display previously played tracks. In the Default Display mode you can turn the **knob** (radio) or use the **UP/DOWN buttons** (remote) to view the Replay List. You can scroll up and down the list by turning the **knob**. Press the **Select button** to make a selection. Older info is displayed at the bottom of the list.

#### To enter the Replay mode:


Press the >II or  **button**.

#### To pause:

- 1 Press the > II button.
- 2 To resume play, press the >II button again.

#### To listen to the previous track:

1 Press the button to skip back to a previous track.



- 2 If the current track has been playing for longer than 5 seconds, it is played from its beginning. If the current track has been playing for less than 5 seconds, the previous track is played.
- 3 Press the **< button** to rewind within the song.



#### To listen to the next track:

- 1 Press the **» button** to skip to the next track.
- 2 Press and hold the > button to fast-forward within the song.



# **Special Features**

#### TuneSelect favorite artists and songs

TuneSelect finds your favorite artist and song whenever they're being played on any channel of the currently-tuned service. MiRGE can track up to 20 of your favorite artists or songs.

- 1 When you hear a favorite artist or song, press and hold the SELECT button for 2 seconds.
- 2 To be notified when the song is played on any channel in the currently-tuned service, highlight TuneSelect Song. To be notified when the current artist is played on any channel in the currently-tuned service, highlight TuneSelect Artist. Then press the Select button.
- 3 When an artist or song that you have TuneSelected plays on any channel of the currently-tuned service, you'll hear a special tone and see a message. To switch to that channel, press the Select button.





# To remove an artist or song from your TuneSelect list:

- Press the Menu button.
- 2 Highlight EDIT ALERTS, and press the SELECT button.
- 3 Highlight EDIT TUNESELECT, and press the SELECT button.
- 4 Highlight the artist or song you want to remove from your TuneSelect list, and press the Select button.
- 5 Highlight Do Not Alert to disable the alert for that artist or song. Press the Select button. Highlight Delete to remove the artist or song from your list. Press the Select button.



# **Special Features**



TIP! You can switch between ALERT ON ARTIST and ALERT ON SONG at the "Edit Alerts > Edit TuneSelect" sub menu:

- To Alert On an artist name, select a song title and choose ALERT ON ARTIST.
   Press the Select button.
- To Alert On a song title, select an artist name and choose ALERT On Song.
   Press the Select button.



TIP! You can also TuneSelect artists and songs while in the Replay mode. See page 38.

#### Get stock quotes

You can track the price and daily movement for up to 20 of your favorite stock symbols.

- NOTE! Information about most stocks and indices listed on the NYSE, AMEX, or NASDAQ is available. Market information is delayed approximately 25 minutes. Stock data provided by ComStock, Inc.
  - 1 Press the Menu button.
  - 2 Highlight Info Extras, and press the Select button.
  - 3 Highlight Stocks, and press the Select button.
  - 4 If you already have stocks in your list, highlight ADD STOCK and press the Select button. If not, then this step will be skipped for you.
  - 5 Turn the **knob** to display the letters for the stock symbol. Press the **Select button** after each letter.

**TIP!** Your MiRGE will help you complete the symbols for more than 9,000 regularly-traded stocks.

6 When you're finished, press the < or Menu button.



#### To remove a stock:

- Press the Menu button.
- 2 Highlight INFO Extras, and press the Select button.
- 3 Highlight Stocks, and press the Select button.
- 4 Highlight Erase Stocks, and press the Select button.
- 5 Highlight the stock you want to remove from your list, and press the SELECT button.
- 6 Highlight Yes, and press the Select button.



TIP! To remove your entire stock list, highlight ERASE ALL STOCKS, press the SELECT button, highlight YES, and press the SELECT button.

# **Get sports scores**

You can select up to 50 of your favorite sports and teams; you can view their scores and stats at any time.

- 1 Press the Menu button.
- 2 Select Info Extras, and press the Select button.
- 3 Select Sports, and press the Select button.
- 4 Select a favorite sport, and press the Select button.
- 5 If your favorite sport is played by teams, select your favorite team, and press the Select button.
- 6 A check mark appears next to sports/teams you have selected.



# To remove a sport or team from your list:

- 1 Press the Menu button.
- 2 Select Info Extras, and press the Select button.
- 3 Select Sports, and press the Select button.
- 4 Select the sport (or team's sport) to be removed and press the SELECT button.
- 5 If applicable, select the team to be removed, and press the SELECT button.

### To see your stock quotes or sports scores:

- 1 Press the Menu button.
- 2 Highlight Change Display, and press the Select button.
- 3 Highlight DISPLAY APPEARANCE, and press the Select button.
- 4 Highlight DISPLAY, and press the Select button.
- 5 Rotate the **knob** until "Stock" or "Sports" appears, and press the **Select button**. The stock ticker will scroll across the screen.
- 6 Press the < or Menu button when you're finished.



# **Special Features**

#### Locking and unlocking channels

The MiRGE lets you lock channels you do not want others (such as children) to access without your permission. Locked channels will not appear on the Channel List screen, the Category List screen or on the Previous Channel screen. When anyone tries to access a locked channel using Direct Channel Entry (see page 30), the screen will display a *Channel Locked* popup for 3 seconds and the MiRGE will return to the currently-tuned channel.

#### To lock a channel:

- Press the Menu button.
- 2 Highlight Channel Access, then press the Select button.
- 3 Highlight CHANNEL LOCK/UNLOCK, then press the Select button. The ENTER CODE screen is displayed.
- 4 Use the Number buttons to enter a 4-digit code and press the Select button. The first time you access the ENTER CODE screen you will have to re-confirm the code before proceeding.






**NOTE!** Be sure to remember your 4-digit code number. If you forget it, call SIRIUS XM Customer Service for help.

- 5 The SIRIUS CHANNELS / XM
  CHANNELS / ALL EXPLICIT
  CHANNELS (LOCK) screen
  appears. Highlight and
  select SIRIUS CHANNELS
  or XM CHANNELS to lock/
  unlock individual channels
  on the two services.
- 6 The screen will show a list with every channel available on the selected service. Use the knob (radio) or UP/DOWN buttons (remote) to highlight the channels you want to lock or unlock.





7 To lock a channel, press the Select button when it is highlighted. A lock icon will appear to the left of the channel name. If the channel is already locked, pressing the Select button when it is highlighted will unlock it. The lock icon next to the channel name will disappear.

# **Special Features**

8 ALL EXPLICIT CHANNELS: This option locks (or unlocks) all channels that SIRIUS XM Radio advises contain explicit language and/or graphic content. (Explicit SIRIUS channels can be found at www.sirius.com/mature; explicit XM channels are marked with an XL in their channel names.)


Turn the **knob** to display Lock, then press the **Select button**. To unlock the explicit channels, turn the **knob** to display UNLOCK, then press the **Select button**.

- NOTE! If you select ALL EXPLICIT CHANNELS (LOCK) you can still lock individual channels in either the SIRIUS or XM service, as explained in steps 5 7 on page 49. Locked explicit channels will not appear in the individual channel lists.
- 9 If you lock a channel that has been saved as a favorite channel (see page 32) it will be cleared and that number button entry will be empty.

#### Changing the Lock Code

Once you have set the Lock Code you can change it.

- 1 Press the MENU button.
- 2 Highlight CHANNEL Access, then press the Select button.
- 3 Highlight EDIT CODE, then press the SELECT button. The ENTER CODE screen is displayed.



- 4 Use the Number buttons to enter your current 4-digit lock code, then press the Select button. The ENTER NEW CODE screen appears.
- 5 Use the Number buttons to enter your new 4-digit code, then press the Select button. You will be prompted to confirm the new code.
- 6 Re-enter the new 4-digit code. A Code Saved screen will be displayed.






# Turning the FM modulator ON/OFF

If you are using the XM SureConnect or XM FM Direct Adapter to transmit audio to your car audio system, you must turn the FM Modulator **ON** and set the FM frequency on both your MiRGE and your car radio.

- 1 Press the Menu button.
- 2 Highlight VEHICLE MODE, and press the SELECT button. The VEHICLE MODE screen will appear.
- 3 Highlight FM Modulator, and press the Select button.



- 4 Turn the knob until On appears, and press the Select button.
- 5 Your MiRGE automatically scans for all available FM frequencies and shows you a list.
- 6 Use the knob (radio) or UP/DOWN buttons (remote) to locate a suitable FM frequency from the list and press the Select button.
- 7 Set your car radio to the frequency you selected.



TIP! The best FM frequency to use is displayed at the top of the list. We recommend choosing that frequency. If you are not satisfied with the sound quality, select a different FM frequency from the list (or select View All Frequencies to see 100 frequencies), press the Select button, and tune your car stereo to that frequency.

#### Finding an FM frequency

If necessary, you can have your MiRGE search for FM frequencies at any time.

- 1 With the FM Modulator set to **ON**, press and hold **jump** for two seconds.
- 2 Your MiRGE automatically scans for available FM frequencies.
- 3 Locate a suitable FM frequency from the list and press the Select button.
- 4 Set your car radio to the frequency selected.

#### OR

- 1 Press the Menu button.
- 2 Highlight Vehicle Mode, and press the Select button.
- 3 With the FM Modulator ON, highlight Frequency Finder and press the Select button.



- 4 Your MiRGE automatically scans for and shows you a list of available FM frequencies.
- 5 Use the knob (radio) or UP/DOWNbuttons(remote) to locate a suitable FM frequency from the list and press the Select button.

# Setting the Line Out level

To connect the MiRGE Vehicle Dock's Audio Out jack directly to your car's audio system to transmit audio, you can:

- · Use the included cassette adapter
- Use your car stereo's audio input (labeled "Aux In", or similar)

Either of these methods will give you the best audio quality. When using either of these methods you can adjust the MiRGE's audio level to match the level of the other sources in your car audio system.

- 1 Press the MENU button.
- 2 Highlight Vehicle Mode, and press the Select button.
- 3 Highlight LINE OUT LEVEL, and press the SELECT button.
- NOTE! LINE OUT LEVEL IS available only when the FM Modulator is turned OFF.



- 4 Turn the knob to increase or decrease the audio level.
- 5 Press the Select button.



**NOTE!** Do not use the Line Out Level function as a volume control; use your car stereo's volume control instead. Line Out Level is used to adjust the volume level to match other audio sources (your CD player, other FM stations, or an MP3 player).




TIP! If using your MiRGE in a home stand (sold separately) or sound system (sold separately), press the MENU button, then select LINE OUT LEVEL.

# Aiming the antenna for best reception

For best reception, your MiRGE's antenna should have a 360-degree unobstructed view of the sky. In large cities there are networks of ground repeaters to help increase the signal coverage.

Your MiRGE can help you aim the antenna for best reception.

- Press the Menu button.
- 2 Highlight SIGNAL INDICATOR, and press the SELECT button. The SIGNAL INDICATOR SCREEN will appear.
- 3 The *blue* bars indicate the SIRIUS signal strength; the



- yellow bars indicate the XM signal strength. The SAT bars indicate the strength of the signal currently being received from the satellites; the TER bars indicate the strength of the signal currently being received from any ground repeaters.
- 4 If you are having trouble getting a strong signal, change the antenna's orientation or location to maximize the length of the SAT bars.
- 5 Press the Select button when you're finished.

# **Display Settings**

To change the display's brightness and backlight timer:

- 1 Press the Menu Button.
- 2 Highlight Change Display, and press the Select button.
- 3 Highlight DISPLAY SETTINGS, and press the SELECT button.
- 4 You can change:
  - Brightness: Highlight Brightness and press the Select button.

    Turn the knob to adjust the brightness. Press the Select button when you're finished.
  - Backlight: Highlight BACKLIGHT and press the SELECT button. Turn the knob to highlight the desired timer setting for the backlight (Always On, 1 Minute, 30 seconds, 15 seconds). Press the SELECT button when you're finished.

# Display appearance

At times, weather can negatively affect the visual quality of scrolling text. By default, Stock information scrolls and Sport information pages.



**NOTE!** Stock and sports information will be displayed as long as one either the SIRIUS or XM service is activated.

- 1 Press the Menu button.
- 2 Highlight Change Display, and press the Select button.
- 3 Highlight Display Appearance, and press the Select button.
  - Stocks Select Stocks, and press the Select button. Highlight either Scrolling (the stock ticker will scroll across the screen) or Paging (stock information will appear one page at a time). Press the Select button when you're finished.
  - Sports Highlight Sports, and press the Select button. Highlight either Scrolling (scores will scroll across the screen) or Paging (scores willappear one page at a time). Press the Select button when you're finished.

#### Setting the time

The actual time is provided by the satellite signal. You can set the time zone where you reside, whether your area observes Daylight Savings Time, and the clock's format.

#### To set your time zone:

- 1 Press the Menu button.
- 2 Highlight Set Time and press the Select button.
- 3 Highlight SET CLOCK and press the SELECT button.
- 4 Highlight Select TIME ZONE and press the SELECT button.
- 5 Turn the knob to highlight your time zone and press the Select button.

### To set Daylight Savings Time to Auto or OFF:

- 1 Press the Menu button.
- 2 Highlight Set Time and press the Select button.
- 3 Highlight SET CLOCK and press the SELECT button.
- 4 Highlight DayLight Savings and press the Select button.

- 5 Turn the knob to highlight Auto if your area observes Daylight Savings Time, or to highlight Off if your area does not observe Daylight Savings Time.
- 6 Press the Select button.


#### To change the format of the time:

- 1 Press the Menu button.
- 2 Highlight SET TIME and press the SELECT button.
- 3 Highlight SET CLOCK and press the SELECT button.
- 4 Highlight Hour Mode and press the Select button.
- 5 Highlight 12 to display the time using a standard 12-hour clock, or highlight 24 to display the time using a 24-hour (military) clock
- 6 Press the Select button.

# Automatic power

Usually, your MiRGE turns on automatically when it is plugged-in and receiving power. You can change this so you must manually turn the radio on/off each time.


- Press the Menu button.
- 2 Highlight SET TIME and press the SELECT button.
- 3 Highlight Automatic Power and press the Select button.
- 4 Turn the knob to highlight On to have your radio turn on automatically when it is plugged in, or to highlight OFF to turn your radio on manually after it is plugged in.
- 5 Press the Select button.



#### Delayed power

This option is useful if you leave your MiRGE in the Vehicle Dock and your vehicle's cigarette lighter is always powered.

- 1 Press the Menu button.
- 2 Highlight SET TIME and press the SELECT button. The SET TIME screen appears.
- 3 Highlight Delayed Power and press the Select button. Turn the knob to display the amount of time (60, 90, 120, or 180 minutes) that should pass before the MiRGE turns OFF automatically.
- 4 Press the Select button.



#### Sleep timer

Your MiRGE has a sleep timer that can automatically shut off the unit after a period of time. The sleep timer is set to OFF at the factory, but you can set it for 15, 30, 45, or 60 minutes.



**NOTE!** The Sleep Timer is available only when you're using the MiRGE with the home stand and sound systems (sold separately).

- Press the Menu button.
- 2 Highlight SET TIME, and press the SELECT button.
- 3 Highlight SLEEP TIMER, and press the SELECT button.
- 4 Turn the **knob** to display the amount of time (15, 30, 45, or 60 minutes) that should pass before the radio automatically turns off.
- 5 Press the Select button.



# Factory defaults

You can clear all of your personal settings (such as Favorite Channels, Tune-Select and Stock information) and return the radio to its out-of-the-box state.

- 1 Press the Menu button.
- 2 Highlight Factory Defaults, and press the Select button.
- 3 Select Yes to clear your personal settings or select No to keep your personal settings.



NOTE! The Factory Defaults procedure does not reset your Channel Lock code (see pages 48 - 51).

# Troubleshooting

# **Troubleshooting**

The MiRGE has been designed and built to be trouble-free but if you experience a problem, try this:

- · Check that all connections are firm and secure.
- Make sure the vehicle's cigarette lighter/auxiliary power socket is clean and free of corrosion.
- If you are using MiRGE in a vehicle, check the car power adapter fuse by unscrewing the ribbed end of the adapter. If required, replace the fuse with a 2-amp fuse only.

If you see this on the screen:	Try this
Acquiring signal	Make sure the antenna is properly mounted outside of the vehicle.
	Move the antenna away from any obstructed areas. For example, if you are parked in an underground garage, you should receive a signal after leaving the garage. If you are using the MiRGE at home, the antenna should have a 360-degree unobstructed view of the entire sky.
Check Antenna	Make sure that the antenna cable is firmly and securely plugged into the cradle. Make sure the cable is not bent or broken.
	Turn the MiRGE OFF, then ON, to reset this message.
Channel Unavailable	The channel you've selected is no longer available. Tune to another channel.

If you see this on the screen:	Try this
Channel Off Air (XM only)	The XM channel you've selected is not currently broadcasting. Tune to another channel.
Loading	Your MiRGE is acquiring audio or program information from the satellite signal. This message usually goes away in a few seconds.
SIRIUS Updating (SIRIUS only)	SIRIUS XM is updating your MiRGE with the latest SIRIUS firmware. Wait until the update is done.
Updating Channels xx% Complete (SIRIUS only)	SIRIUS XM is updating your SIRIUS channel list. Wait until the update is done.
Subscription Updated Press Any Key To Continue (SIRIUS only)	Your SIRIUS subscription has been updated. Press any button to continue listening.
Channel Unauthorized	The channel you've selected is not part of your current SIRIUS or XM subscription. Call 1-888-539-7474 to subscribe.
-	No program information, such as artist name, song title, or channel exists.
If this happens:	Try this
MiRGE shuts off unexpectedly	If the Delayed Power or Sleep Timer are activated, the MiRGE will turn off after the selected length of time. Turn off the Delayed Power or Sleep Timer feature (see pages 65 - 66).
You do not receive all the SIRIUS or XM channels you subscribed to	If you have not yet activated your SIRIUS XM subscription, refer to <i>Activation</i> on page 23.

# **Troubleshooting**

If this happens:	Try this
No audio	Check all cables between the MiRGE and your audio system for a firm and secure connection.
No song title or artist name is displayed	The information may not be available, or updates may be in progress.
No audio when listening via an FM radio	Check that your MiRGE and your car radio are tuned to the same FM frequency. See <i>Finding an FM frequency</i> , on page 55.
Audio fades or has static when listening	Check all cables for a firm and secure connection.
	If the problem persists, it might be interference from another FM channel. See <i>Finding an FM Frequency</i> on page 55 when using the XM SureConnect (sold separately) or the XM FM Direct adapter (sold separately).
Audio sounds too quiet	Raise or lower the FM audio level until the sound quality improves. See <i>Setting the Line Out level</i> , on page 57.
Traffic and Weather channels sound different from other channels	These channels use a different audio technology than the other channels so they often sound different from other channels.
The sales demo is playing	Your antenna is not properly connected or you are not receiving the SIRIUS XM signal. Check that the antenna is connected properly and its view of the SIRIUS and XM satellites is not obstructed.
