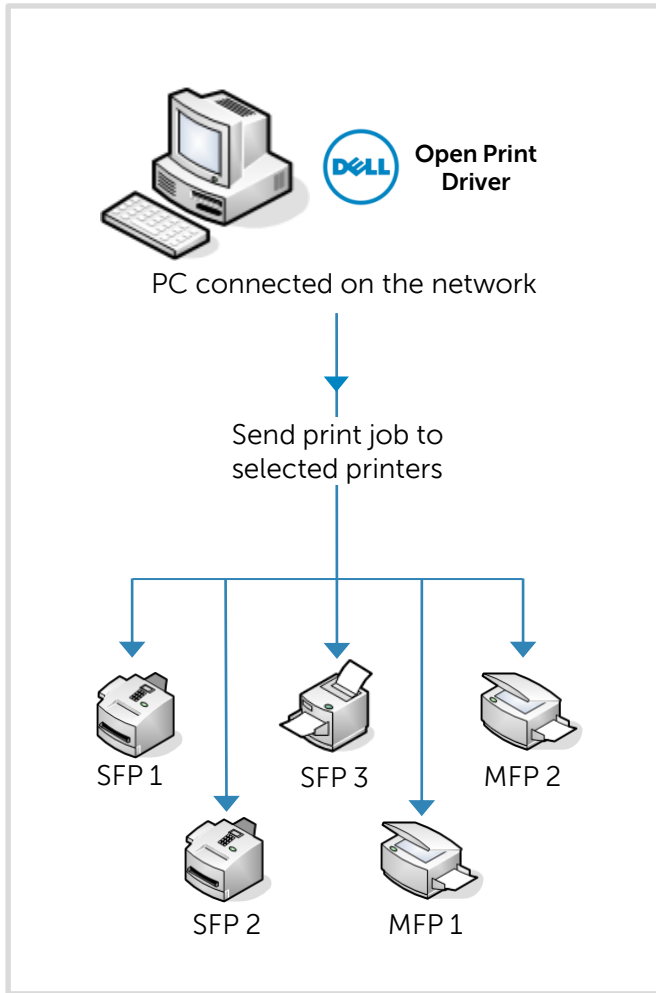

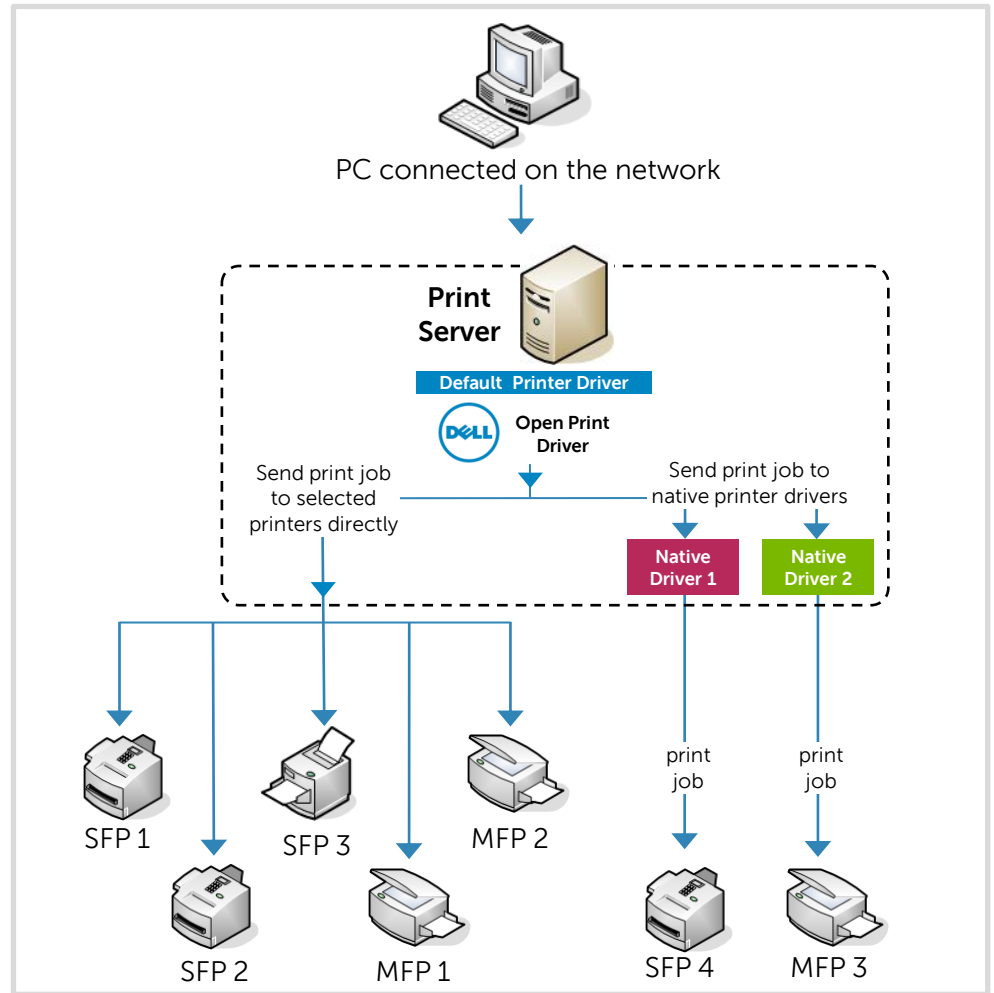


Dell Open Print Driver (OPD)– Configurations

(2) Connect via Print Server using OPD as default driver



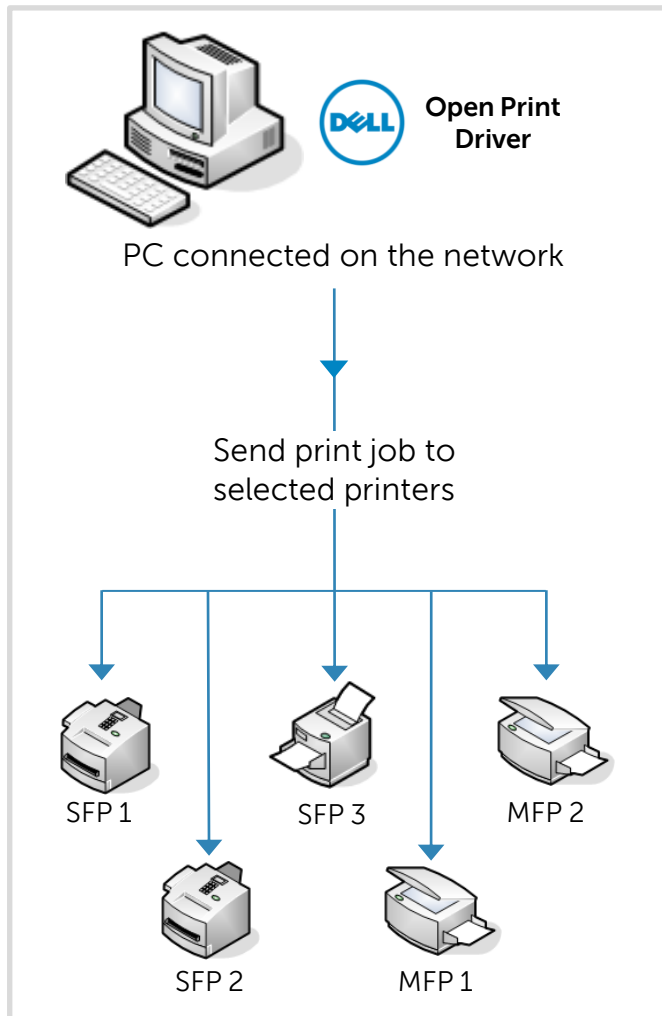
SFP - Single Function Printer

Dell Open Print Driver (OPD)

(1) Direct Connect



- Dell OPD is installed on the client PCs.
- Dell OPD searches for all available printers on the network. Users can print to all available printers discovered and additionally, be able to set up to **5 frequently used / favourite printers.**
- Dell OPD communicates directly with the supported printers and is able to display the available accessories on the printers such as duplexor, 2nd paper tray etc.
- Users can configure on their own for additional features available on generic printers.

Recommended for SMBs with multiple printers and limited IT admin resources

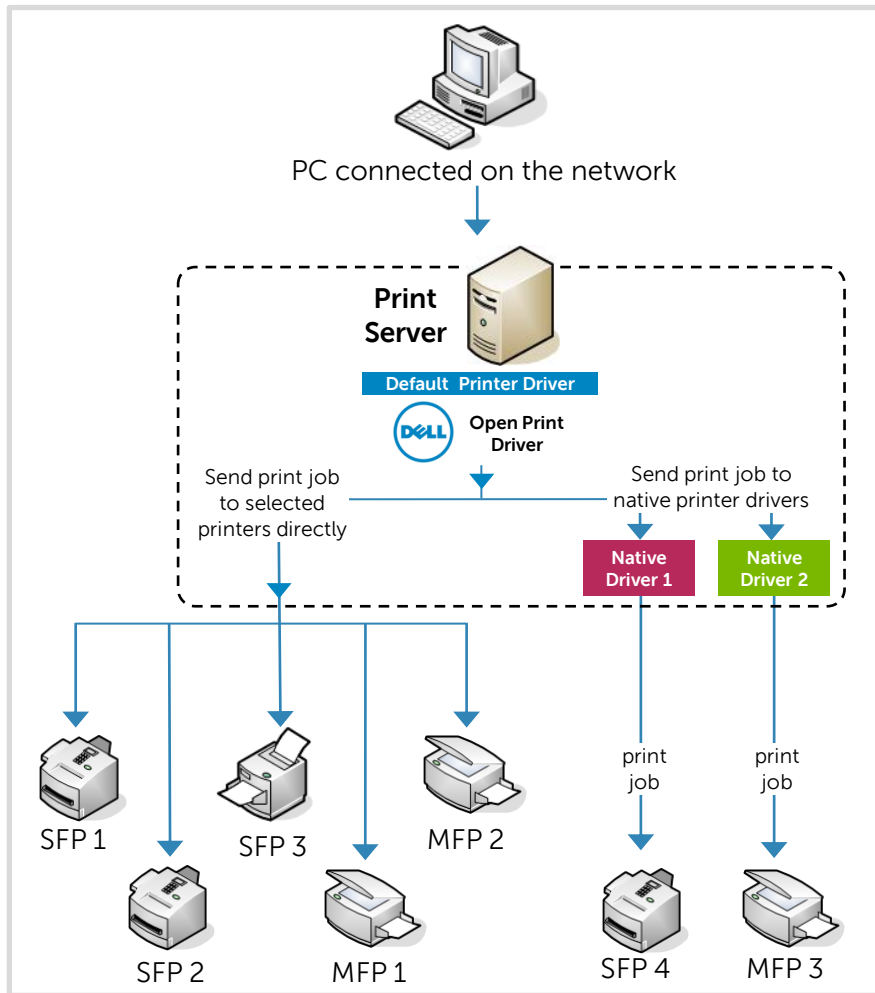

Dell Open Print Driver (OPD)

(2) Connect via Print Server using OPD as default driver



- Dell OPD is installed on the Print Server.
- The IT administrator configures OPD with the various accessories that are connected to the individual printers.
- User PC is connected to the print server queue. When preparing to send a print job, the user will be viewing Dell OPD user interface to select print options.
- Before selecting the desired printer for sending a print job, the user can view the accessories available for each printer, that are configured by the IT administrator.
- The IT administrator can also direct the Print Queues to Dell OPD, which in turn directs to the native drivers of the printers.

Recommended for SMBs and small workgroups of Large Enterprises with multiple printers and available IT support management
