



- ④ 不要将新、旧电池或不同型号的电池混合使用。





- ❻ **S-VIDEO INPUT:** Connect an S-Video cable to the S-Video jack on the DVD, Laser Disc Player and Camcorder (or similar). S-VIDEO shares the AUDIO 3 jacks with VIDEO 3.
- ❼ **COMPONENT HDTV INPUT (BNC):** Same as CMPT INPUT.
- ❽ **SUBWOOPER OUTPUT:** Connect to an active subwoofer via an audio cable.
- ❾ **VIDEO OUTPUT:** Connect other TV's video jack to the VID OUT jack on the TV for video output.
- ❿ **AUDIO OUTPUT:** Connect other TV's audio jacks to the AUDIO OUT jacks on the TV for audio output.
- ⓫ **POWER AMPLIFIER OUTPUT:** Connect the power amplifier output signals to other speakers.




### REMOTE CONTROL ILLUSTRATION

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For using the remote control, follow these instructions:

- ❶ Open the back cover of the remote control, then insert batteries with polarities matching with the marks inside the battery compartment, at last close the back cover.
- ❷ Point the remote control toward the infra-red remote sensor on the main unit. If there is an obstacle between the main unit and remote control, the remote control may not operate properly.
- ❸ Change batteries immediately once the remote control is found to be not working properly.
- ❹ Do not mix new batteries with old ones, or batteries of different brands.
- ❺ When the battery is to be exhausted, electrolyte-leaking may occur and damage may be caused to the remote control. When the operation is not sensitive, the batteries may become weak, so please replace the batteries.
- ❻ If the remote control is not to be used for a long period of time, please remove the batteries to avoid electrolyte leaking.

# SETTING UP YOUR TV

Follow the instructions below to turn on your TV.


- 1 Connect the TV set to an AC power supply outlet. (Note: The graphics are for representation only.)

- 2 Turn on the TV.

Press the "I" button of the power switch to turn on the TV. When the TV is turned on, press the **STANDBY** button on the remote control to put the TV set into standby mode. The power indicator lights up in red. In standby mode, press the **STANDBY, VOLUME UP** or **PROGRAM UP/DOWN** buttons to turn on the TV.

- 3 Turn off the TV.

Press the **STANDBY** button on the remote control to put the TV set into standby mode. The standby indicator lights up. To turn off the TV, press the "O" button of the power switch.



**Note:** Unplug the set from the AC outlet when it is not to be used for a long period of time.

- 4 Change the TV channel or adjust the TV sound.

Press **PROGRAM UP/DOWN** on the remote control to change TV channels (press **VOLUME UP/DOWN** to adjust the sound).

Press **PROGRAM UP/DOWN** on the TV set to change TV channels (press **VOLUME UP/DOWN** to adjust the sound).

Press the numeric buttons on the remote control to enter a channel number directly. (After a while, the set will turn to the channel automatically.)




# MENU CONTROLS

This model adopts a screen menu system to navigate your operation. This section explains how to use the buttons on the remote control to operate the menu system to get the satisfying effects.

## 1. BASIC OPERATION

- ① Press **MENU** on the remote control or on the TV set to display the main menu.
- ② Press **PROGRAM UP/DOWN** to select the desired menu/item.
- ③ Press **VOLUME UP** to enter the selected menu/item.
- ④ Press **MENU** to go back to the previous menu.
- ⑤ To change the setting of an option, press **VOLUME UP**, then press **VOLUME UP/DOWN** or **PROGRAM UP/DOWN**.
- ⑥ Press **MENU** to confirm the setting.
- ⑦ Press **MENU** to close the menu.

*Note:* The buttons on the TV set have the same functions as the corresponding buttons on the remote control.




The following descriptions and schemes apply to TV mode mainly. There will be a note if there is exception.

## 2. PICTURE SETTINGS

*Note:* All the schemes below are for representation only.

**BRIGHTNESS**--Adjusts the background brightness of the picture. It is usually used together with **CONTRAST**.

- ① Press **MENU** on the remote control to display the main menu.
- ② Press **PROGRAM UP/DOWN** to select the **PICTURE** option.
- ③ Press **VOLUME UP** to enter the next level menu, then press **PROGRAM UP/DOWN** to select the **BRIGHTNESS** option.
- ④ Press **VOLUME UP** to enter the adjustment status, and press **VOLUME UP/DOWN** to adjust the brightness.
- ⑤ Press **MENU** to exit the adjustment status, and press again to go back to the previous menu.



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# MENU CONTROLS

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**Note:** The operation methods for the following options are similar.

**CONTRAST**--Adjusts the difference between the light and dark areas of the picture. To get better picture quality, contrast should be adjusted to the proper value.

**SATURATION**--Adjusts the richness of color. This option cannot be adjusted in VGA and HDMI modes.

**SHARPNESS**--Adjusts the sharpness of the picture. This option cannot be adjusted in VGA and HDMI modes.

**HUE**--Adjusts the hue of the picture.

**Note:** This option is available only in NTSC mode.

**COLOR TONE**--Adjusts the color temperature of the picture.

**Note:** There are three color temperatures available. **COOL** is for a more blue palette of picture colors, **WARM** is for a more red palette of picture colors, and **NORMAL** is between the former two.

**BACKLIGHT**--Adjusts the back light brightness of the LCD screen.

**Tip:** The lower the back light is adjusted, the more energy the machine can save. Suggest adjusting the back light to a lower level if the environmental brightness is low.

**PIC MODE (PICTURE MODE)**--Selects an appropriate picture effect.

**Note:** There are four picture modes available: STANDARD, SOFT, BRIGHT and USER.

**VOLUME**--Adjusts the volume of the TV.

The child lock includes time lock and content lock. The descriptions are as follows:

1. When the time limit is used up, the time lock takes effect and the following information appears:

- ③ Press **VOLUME UP** to enter the next level menu, then press **PROGRAM UP/DOWN** to select the **CH EDIT** option. Press **VOLUME UP** to enter the sub-menu and select the **PROGRAM EDIT** option.
- ④ Press **VOLUME UP** to enter the **PROGRAM EDIT** sub-menu. Refer to the figures to operate.
- ⑤ Press **MENU** to exit the edit status, and press again to go back to the previous menu.

**Note:** The contents of the channel list depends on the local conditions. Please consult your dealer for details.

**Note:** The dashed lines are used to help you understand. They do not appear on the screen.





- ③ Press **PROGRAM UP/DOWN** to select a channel name and press **VOLUME UP** to confirm. The selected channel name displays at the **CH. When you use the program guide function, you can select the channel quickly by using the channel name you defined.









## 1. SOURCE

- 1 Press the **SOURCE** button on the remote control or on the TV set to display the **SOURCE** menu.

## 7. OPERATION

Press the **LEFT/RIGHT** button to select the **op** icon on the root menu, then press the **ENTER** button. The operation interface appears (see figure 2).

### File Operation

- 1 When displaying the operation interface, press the **UP, DOWN, LEFT** or **RIGHT** button and the **ENTER** button to select a file, then press the **USB MENU** button (see figure 3).
- 2 Press the **UP/DOWN** button to select **Copy, Paste** or **Delete**, then press the **ENTER** button to complete the operation.

### Notes:

1. In this state, the system can recognize any file formats, but the file icons do not display.
2. This function only applies to files. It does not apply to folders.

### TV Format

- 1 When displaying the operation interface, press the **UP/DOWN** button to select **TV Format**, then press the **ENTER** button.
- 2 Press the **UP/DOWN** button and the **ENTER** button to select the output format: **720P** or **1080I**.

### Jpeg Play Mode

- 1 When displaying the operation interface, press the **UP/DOWN** button to select **Jpeg PlayMode**, then press the **ENTER** button.
- 2 Press the **UP/DOWN** button and the **ENTER** button to select **Jpeg Quality Priority** or **Jpeg Speed Priority**.

### Language

- 1 When displaying the operation interface, press the **UP/DOWN** button to select **Language**, then press the **ENTER** button.
- 2 Press the **UP/DOWN** button and the **ENTER** button to select **English** or **Chinese**.

## 8. SUPPORTED USB DEVICES AND FILE TYPES

- 1 Supports standard USB 1.1 devices, such as USB disk, MP3 player and mobile hard disk (regarding digital camera, the connection mode should be set to PTP).
- 2 Supports FAT and FAT32 file systems on USB 1.1 and USB 2.0 disks and mobile hard disks. The NTFS file system is not supported.
- 3 Supports multimedia file types such as JPEG, BMP, TIFF (uncompressed), GIF, MP3, WMA and MPEG4 (Divx3.x, Divx4.x, Divx5.x, Xvid, etc.).
- 4 Supports PictBridge compatible printers with Mini-USB socket.

### Notes:

1. The current of USB interface is limited. Do not connect many devices via a USB HUB. Do not use two or more mobile hard disks at the same time.
2. The system does not support WMA files encoded in LPC.
3. The size of a JPEG file can not exceed 8MB.
4. Only TXT files encoded in GB and ANSI are supported.
5. Please backup your data on the USB devices to avoid data loss due to misoperation or something else.

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# SHORTCUTS

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This section explains the shortcuts and convenient functions.

## PICTURE

- 1 Press the **PICTURE** button on the remote control to enter the adjustment status. Current picture state will display when you press the button the first time.
- 2 Press the **PICTURE** button repeatedly to select different picture effect.
- 3 The shortcut display will disappear in 3 seconds if you stop adjusting.

## STILL

- 1 Press the **STILL** button on the remote control to turn on the still function.
- 2 Press the **STILL** button again to turn off the still function.

## SOUND

- 1 Press the **SOUND** button on the remote control to enter the adjustment status. Current sound state will display when you press the button the first time.
- 2 Press the **SOUND** button repeatedly to select different sound effect.
- 3 The shortcut display will disappear in 3 seconds if you stop adjusting.

## PROGRAM GUIDE

**Note:** Based on the channel list you have defined using the program edit function, you can select a desired channel quickly.

# TROUBLESHOOTING

## NO PICTURE, NO SOUND

1. Check if the fuse or circuit breaker is working.
2. Plug another electrical device into the outlet to make sure it is working or turned on.
3. Power plug is bad contact with the outlet.
4. Check the signal source.

## NO COLOR

1. Change the color system.
2. Adjust the saturation.
3. Try another channel. Black-white program may be received.

## REMOTE CONTROL DOES NOT WORK

1. Change the batteries.
2. Batteries are not installed correctly.
3. Main power is not connected.

## NO PICTURE, NORMAL SOUND

1. Adjust the brightness and contrast.
2. Broadcasting failure may happen.

## NORMAL PICTURE, NO SOUND

1. Press the **VOLUME UP** button to increase volume.
2. Volume is set to mute, press **MUTE** to restore sound.
3. Change the sound system.
4. Broadcasting failure may happen.

## UNORDERLY RIPPLES ON THE PICTURE

It is usually caused by local interference, such as cars, daylight lamps and hair driers. Adjust the antenna to minimize the interference.

## BLANK SCREEN IN VGA MODE

Perhaps the TV can not recognize the resolution set by the PC. Suggest to change to the best resolution or other standard resolutions of the Windows system.

## SNOWY DOTS AND INTERFERENCE

If the antenna is located in the fringe area of a television signal where the signal is weak, the picture may be marred by dots. When the signal is extremely weak, it may be necessary to install a special antenna to improve the reception.

1. Adjust the position and orientation of the indoor/outdoor antenna.
2. Check the connection of antenna.
3. Fine tune the channel.
4. Try another channel. Broadcasting failure may happen.

## IGNITION

Black spots or horizontal streaks appear, or the picture flutters or drifts. This is usually caused by interference from car ignition system, neon lamps, electric drills, or other electrical appliance.

## GHOST

Ghosts are caused by the television signal following two paths. One is the direct path, the other is reflected from tall buildings, hills, or other objects. Changing the direction or position of the antenna may improve the reception.

## RADIO FREQUENCY INTERFERENCE

This interference produces moving ripples or diagonal streaks, and in some case, loss of contrast in the picture. Find out and remove the radio interference source.
