# **Child-Lock**

The Child-Lock system has been developed to prevent children from pressing any button to change the program during operation.



Delayed Washing can be set easily from 3 hours to 19 hours.

#### **Auto Restart**

Although the washing machine is turned off by a power failure, it restarts automatically in its stopped process when power is supplied again and the process is properly adjusted and it will be the same when the machine unplugged in operation is plugged in again.

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

- full packaging and transit bolts must be removed before the appliance is used. Serious damage may occur if this is not done.
- fuAny plumbing work required to install this appliance should be carried out by a qualified plumber or a competent person.
- fuAny electrical work required to install this appliance should be carried out by a qualified electrician or a competent person.
- ftMake sure that the appliance does not stand on its electrical supply cable.
- fulf the machine is situated on a carpeted floor, please adjust the feet to ensure that air can circulate freely.
- fUAlways unplug the appliance and turn off the water tap after use.
- ftDo not overload the appliance.
- ftOnly wash fabrics which are designed to be machine washed. If in doubt, follow the instructions you find on the label of the item itself.
- fuAvoid electric heaters, candles, etc. near the machine. It may ignite or deform the machine.
- ftDon;tIsprinkle water. It may cause a fire or electric shock.
- ftUse the exclusive AC 220V-240V outlet with ground terminal. Do not use an extension cord or

- double adapter.
- ftMake sure that all pockets are empty. Hard, sharp objects such as coins, safety pins, nails, screws or stones can cause extensive damage.
- ftDo not wash laundry stained with edible oil, machine oil, dry-cleaning oil, gasoline, etc. It may cause fire or explosions.
- fuThis appliance is designed for domestic use. It must not be used for purposes other than those for which it was designed.
- ftDo not machine wash fabrics which are saturated with petroleum products. If volatile cleaning fluids have been used, make sure that they are thoroughly removed from the fabric before it is placed in the appliance.
- f Do not operate near places with ignitable material such as gasoline, benzene, etc. or inflammable gas leak. Due to volatile nature of these material, It can cause fire or explosions.
- ftUse only the recommended quantities of fabric softener. An excessive amount could damage the laundry.
- fuleave the porthole door slightly ajar between washes to preserve the door seal.
- ftBefore you open the door of the machine check that the water has drained.

  Do not open the door if you can still see water.
- fuPets and children may climb into the washing machines. Check your appliance each time before use.
- fuThe glass door becomes very hot during washing. Keep children away from the appliance while it is in use.
- ftYou should not attempt to repair the machine yourself. Repairs carried out by inexperienced or unqualified persons may cause injury and/or more serious faults to the machine.
- futhis product should be serviced by an authorized Service Centre only, and only genuine spare parts should be used.
- ftWhen disposing of your old washing machine, the electric cable must be cut off and the door catch must be made inoperative to avoid it becoming a death trap for a child.





# Installation



ftKeep the transit bolts and spanner for future use in case the machine is to be transported again.



fulf the washer is not levelled, it may cause noise or vibration.

#### **§ How to disassemble the transit bolts.**

fullo protect the washer during transportation, the special 4 bolts are locked. Before operating the washer, remove

( If they are not removed, it may cause heavy vibration, noise and malfunction)

- 1. Locate the 4 bolts that secure the washer.
- 2. Unscrew the 4 bolts with a spanner provided.
- 3. Take out the 4 bolts.

### **S** Level adjustment

#### 1. Select a place for installation

fuPlace it on a firm and even floor fuPlace it more than 2cm away from the wall or other furniture

#### 2.Check the gap

fuEnsure all feet are firmly on the floor.

#### 3.Level adjustment

fuAfter adjusting the level, check it by shaking the washer. Readjust the level if necessary.

fuLevelling should be done within 1.5 degree angle.

#### **S** Electrical connection

fuDo not use an extension cord or double adapter.

fulf the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer or its service agents or similarly qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.

fullways unplug the machine and turn off the water supply after use.

ftConnect the machine to an earthed socket in accordance with current wiring regulations.

Caution full the appliance is supplied from a cord extension set or electrical portable outlet device, the cord extension set or electrical portable outlet device should be positioned so it is not subject to splashing or ingress of moisture.

fulf a stationary appliance is provided with a supply cord and a plug, the instructions shall state that the appliance must be positioned so that the plug is accessible.

#### **S Water drain**

ftHook over the edge of a sink using the plastic hose hanger supplied with the machine.

ftMake sure there are no kinks in the hose and that it is not crushed.


Secure the hose so that it can not be dislodged while the appliance is running.


fullhe drain hose should not be placed higher than 85cm above the floor.





# **S** Connecting the inlet hose


- Unscrew the fixing screw to attach the faucet.
- Push the connector up till the rubber packing is in tight contact with the faucet. Then tighten the 4 screws.
- 3 Push the water supply hose vertically upwards so that the rubber packing within in the hose can adhere completely to the faucet and then tighten it by screwing it to the right.











- Make sure that the rubber seal is inside the hose connector.
- Your machine comes with only cold water connection.
- Make sure that there are no kinks in the hose and that it is not crushed.

# **S** Connecting the inlet hose (How to connect the hose of screw type.)

- Two rings are supplied with the water inlet hose in the valve connector in order to prevent water leaks.
- Your machine comes with only cold water connection.
   Connect to cold water using the inlet valve.
- Check water tightness of washing machine connections by turning the tap completely on.
- Periodically check the condition of the hose and replace the hose if necessary.
- Make sure that there are no kinks in the hose and that it is not crushed.







# Preparing your laundry



ft Check pocket for any articles (coin, safety pin, paper clips, etc.)

ftClose zips and fasten button or hooks: loose belt or ribbons should be tied together.

ft Never wash whites and coloureds together.


fuFollow the wash code symbols on each garment label and manufacturer's washing instructions.

# Adding detergent

# **S** Where to place the detergent

ftPull out the detergent drawer. fuPut the detergent and fabric softener in the detergent drawer before washing. fuClose the detergent drawer completely.



The drawer for fabric softener

- Do not leave the fabric softener in the detergent drawer for more than 2 days. (Fabric softener could harden)
- Do not open the drawer during water fill cycle.
- · Softener will automatically add during the last rinsing cycle.
- . Do not fill past MAX indicator,
- Do not use solvents (benzine, etc.)

full he detergent should be used according to the instruction of the detergent manufacturer.

fulf the detergent is used over the recommended amount too many bubbles will be generated thus causing an inferior washing result. Which will cause malfunction.

ftUse detergent only for drum washing machine.

#### Detergent dosages

Do not exceed manufacturer's recommended dosages as shown on the detergent package. The amounts depend on



# Rinse hold

fulf you desire to leave fabrics in the machine without spinning after rinse to prevent them getting wrinkled, you may select rinse Hold by pressing the Rinse button.

 $f \cup To$  drain and spin, press the Rinse button to turn off the rinse Hold lamp.

# Wash program selector

- To programs can be set depending on the type of the laundry.
- That the power button is pressed.


  Coloreds program is automatically set.
- TBy pressing the button, [ Coloreds ¤A Whites a A Synthetic a A Delicate a A Wool ] can be selected.

### **Start/Pause button**

- fWse the button to start or pause wash cycle.
- full he power turns off automatically 4 minutes after the pause button is pressed.

#### **Power button**

ftPress the button to turn power on and off.



### Child - lock

- ftChild Lock system can be set and canceled by pressing both [Temp] and [Eco/Rapid] button simultaneously.
- ftOnce Child Lock is set, all button are inoperable.
- ftChild Lock system can be set anytime even during Power-off, on pause and operation.
- fut is automatically cancelled when an operational error occurs and when the cycle ends.

# ime Delay

Thress the button when delayed washing is needed. The button is pressed, [ 3:00] ]is displayed, A maximum delay of [ 19:00] ]hours can be set. The can be set advances time delay by the hour. The properties of the button to cancel [Time Delay].

# Eco/Rapid

- f Uf you push the Eco/Rapid button in White program, Eco function is selected. Eco function gives you almost the same washing effect as that in 95 ¡€ with less energy consumption
- fulf you push the Eco/Rapid button in Coloreds or Synthetic program, Rapid function is selected. Rapid function reduces the whole time including the washing and rinsing time about by half an hour.

# How to use your washing machine

- § The whole washing process is carried out automatically with just one touch.
- § If no program is selected, Coloreds program will commence.

### § In case of automatic washing

- 1. Press the aPower i button. Coloreds program is automatically set with power on
- 2. Press the Start/Pause button to start the washing machine.
- 3. The Coloreds program is carried out.

fuThe optimum wash program is selected once the load is detected.

### **S** To get the washing program preferred

- 1. Press the iaPower; button.
- 2. Press the program button. By additional push, each light of the programs on the control panel will be turned on in order as follows.; aColoreds

#### [More convenient manual operations of Coloreds program ]

It is more convenient to operate manually in Coloreds program than in others because Coloreds program is first set with power on.

#### In Coloreds,

ftWhen you want wash only, press the [Wash] button to select the washing method.

ftWhen you want rinse only,

press the [Rinse] button to select the rinsing method.

ftWhen you want Spin only,

press the [Spin] button to select the Spin speed,

ft When you want Wash & Rinse only,

press the [Wash] button and [Spin] button respectively to select each method.

ftWhen you want Rinse & Spin only,

press the [Rinse] button and [Spin] button respectively to select each method.

#### 3. Press the Start/Pause button to start the cycle.

fuThe optimum washing is carried out by detecting the amount of the laundry.



#### Completion of washing

fUf the washing is completed, the display shows [ End ] with a beep. fUSwitch off the appliance and turn off the tap.

# **§** To change settings in Child - Lock mode.

ft Child-Lock (If you want to lock all the buttons to prevent a child from setting, you use this option.)

f { The Child system can be programmed and cancelled only by pressing both [ Temp. ] and [ Eco/Rapid ] buttons simultaneously. If you want to change the program when the Child-Lock is on,







fuAccording to the condition of water supply and temperature, the delayed time and the actual washing time can vary slightly.

full he leave [ Power ] button can be pressed to cancel the time delay.

ftPressing the button once will increase the time delay. If the button is pressed continuously, the time increases automatically by the hour.

fuSet the time delay and press the [Start / Pause] button, then the remaining time display stays on with two points blinking between hour and minute.



### S Prepare the washing.

ftPlug the power into the exclusive AC 200-240V outlet.

 $f \cup T$ urn on the water tap.

ftPut in the laundry and close the door.

fuPlace the detergent and fabric softener in the drawer.



### 1. Press the ( aPower; button

2. Press the **Program** selection button to select the program required.

fuSelect the rinse, spin and water temperature.

## **3.** Press the **Time Delay** button

ftSelect the finish time required by pressing the [Time Delay] button

### 4. Press the Start / Pause button



### The Washing is completed at the selected time.

fullake out the laundry, unplug the power plug and turn off the tap.

### The Washing program for when you go out.

fulf you are unable to unload the washing machine at the end of the washing cycle, it is better to select rinse [ Hold ] to reduce wrinkle taking place.

# Maintaining the washer

- Unplug the power plug prior to maintaining.
- S Clean the filter periodically every 3 months.


### S Clean the filter in the inlet valve

f ∪When no water flows through detergent drawer, or filter is clogged with foreign material "no inlet" is displayed on the control panel.



- Open the lower cover cap (¥L) by using coin. Turn the drain plug (¥M) to pull out the hose.
- Unplug the drain plug (\(\cong \mathbb{M}\)), then the water flows out, At this time use a vessel to prevent water flowing on the floor. If the water does not flow any more, turn the pump filter (\(\cong \mathbb{N}\)) open to the



Take out any foreign material from the pump filter (¥N). After cleaning, turn the pump filter (¥N) clockwise and insert the drain plug (¥M)to the original place. close the lower cover cap.




# S To prevent being frozen in winter

**1** Turn off the water tap and remove the inlet hose.






## S When the machine is frozen

**3** Pour the hot water in the drawer and maintain it for 10 minutes for melting






